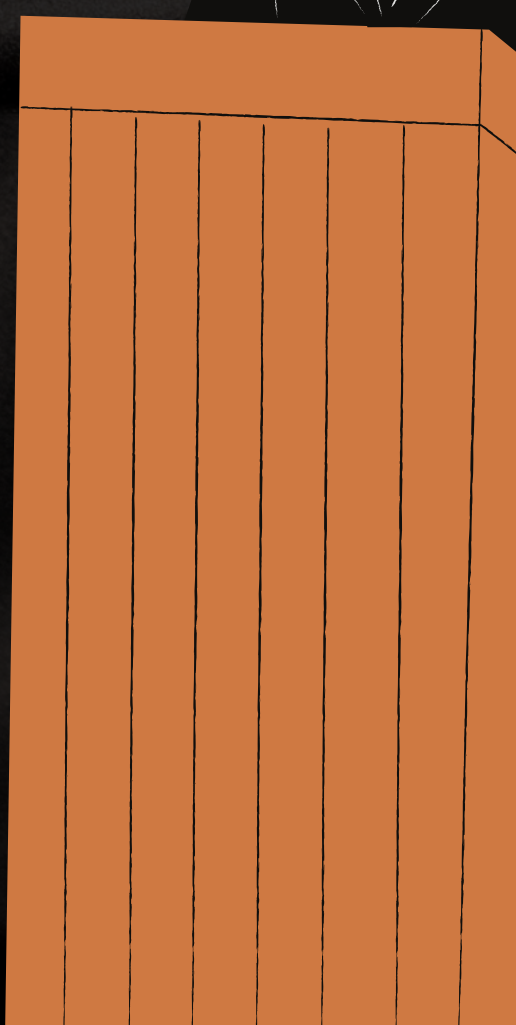

Guidelines for the Speech Competition

Eligibility: Open to all students.

- **Registration:** Participants must register by [6th December] to confirm participation.
- **Topic Selection:** Participants will be given a list of topics to choose from Google Form.
- The content should be relevant to the topics, engaging, and appropriate for a university-level audience.
- Ensure that the speech does not include any sentimental, communal, religious and political comments. (avoid offensive or controversial content)
- Originality and creativity will be encouraged.
- Time limit- (2-3 minutes), a grace period of (30 seconds) for transitions would be allowed.
- Participants must arrive at least 30 minutes before the competition.
- Participants shall not use any electronic device, notes, sheets, books etc.
- **Language:** Participants must deliver the speech in English and avoid the use of any another language.
- No props, costumes, or excessive use of notes.
- No reading directly from scripts or teleprompters.
- Audience and participants should remain respectful during speeches—no interruptions or comments shall be made.
- **Timing:** Make sure your speech stays within the allocated time frame.
- **Dress Code:** Dress professionally or in a manner that is suitable for the event. (University Uniform recommended).
- Avoid distracting clothing, such as excessive patterns, logos, or informal attire.
- **Stay Professional:** Whether you win or not, thank the judges and audience for their time and consideration.
- **Be Open to Feedback:** Accept constructive criticism with grace and use it as an opportunity to improve.
- Respect your fellow competitors, judges, and audience.

Judging Criteria-

1. **Content (40%):** Relevance, depth, originality, and clarity of the speech.
2. **Delivery (40%):** Voice projection, articulation, body language, eye contact, and engagement with the audience.
3. **Structure (20%):** Clear introduction, body, and conclusion. Logical flow and smooth transitions.
